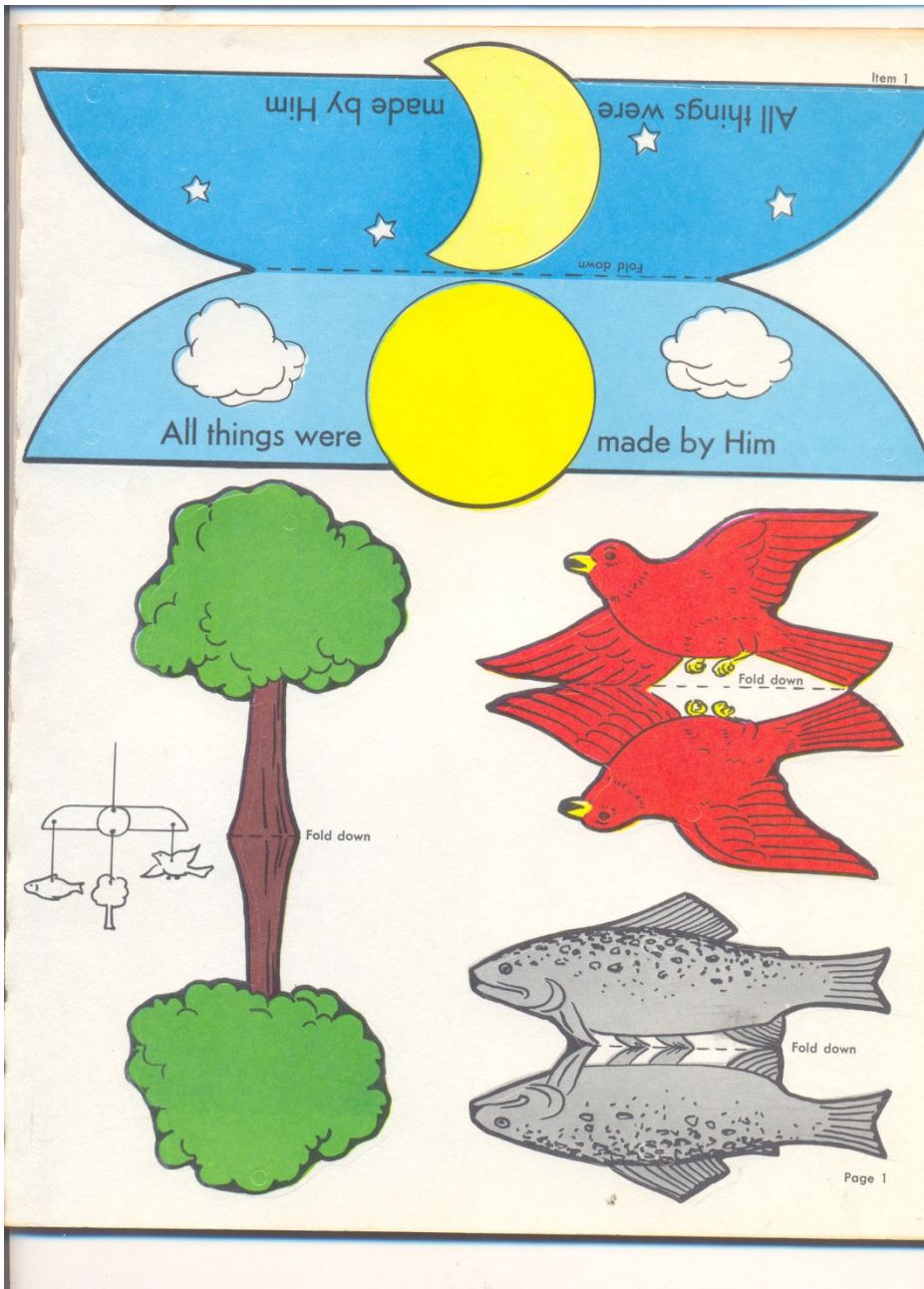


Craft for Kids. God Made Everything: a Mobile.

Needed: paper, scissors, string [4 peeces], crayons if not printed in color, tape or glue; stapler optional. If u dont hav a color printer handy with wich to print the craft out on sturdy paper, u can simply hand-coppy the peeces yurself; they ar that simple. U as the adult or big sister can then color them, or the children can.



As the illustration shows, the fish, bird & tree ar to be cut out, folded dubble and suspended with string from the sky peece. U wil need to punch a hole at each end of the sky and one hafway along it abuv and belo for hanging.

The string for the fish can be cut longer so the fish wil hang loer if dezired. If not cutting holes, uze a stapler to fassen the folded objects to the strings & the strings to the sky. It's a good idea to glue or staple or tape the folded edges together. The completed projects can then be hung from a line or tackd on a bulletin bord.
